

Malcolm served for 28 years in the Military, including active service, plus 20 years as a Lecturer. He has been married to Dawn for 59 years and they have 2 daughters and 5 grandchildren. They have lived in 14 different homes including two in campaign zones. Malcolm has spent twenty years on the Council and has been Mayor 3 times. He has served as Chairman of the most important Committees on Council; PR&F (with Budget), Amenities, and Human Resources for 5 years, plus early years on P&T. Malcolm has served on all sub-Committees/Steering Groups including 3 Standing Orders re-writes plus every Volunteer of the Year group since the first. He has represented the Council on many outside bodies. He was the first Councillor to assist Eric Osmond MBE on Wareham in Bloom; the 2 of them, joined by Brian Holden, landscaped the north roundabout over one 28-hour working weekend.
